REQUIREMENTS FOR ADMISSIONS

At the time of admission to Nursery, Prep and Std.-I, original Birth Certificate issued by the competent authority (Transfer Certificate for Std.-I) is required. For Std.-II onwards, no student will be admitted without submitting the school-leaving certificate of the school last attended. Photocopy of the mark sheet of the previous class for Std.-II onwards is also required. Identity proof and address proof of parent is required for admission, in all classes.

Age of Students: For class Nursery - 3½ years. For class Prep - 4½ years.

ADMISSION TO STD. XI

Registration Formsfor admission to Std.-XI will be issued after the publication of results of Secondary Board Exams.
